On January 1, 2015, the changes to the Arizona Transaction Privilege Tax system (sales tax) substantially altered how many of us do business. On February 24th, Senate bill 1446 was signed into law by Governor Ducey to clarify and better define this new taxing method.

This seminar will explore in detail the legislative changes that will impact your business operations; comparing and contrasting the previous TPN 14-1, the 2015 legislative changes and the new TPN directives currently underway by the DOR.
