Cancellation of Elections

D. If only one person files or no person files a nominating petition or nomination paper for a write-in candidate for an election to fill a district office, the board of supervisors no earlier than seventy -five days before the election may cancel the election for the position and appoint the person who filed the nominating petition or nomination paper to fill the position. If no person files a nominating petition or nomination paper for an election to fill a district office, the board of supervisors no earlier than seventy -five days before the election may cancel the election for that office and that office is deemed vacant and shall be filled as provided by law. A person who is appointed pursuant to this subsection is fully vested with the powers and duties of the office as if elected to that office.
